Overview of Role

The head of IT and the head Business Applications need a strong and analytical person to manage the project portfolio of the Bank. The successful candidate will be responsible for the project office and will work closely with IT management. The role is about the implementation of a well-planned project delivery approach and also direct project management of various IT projects.

Responsibilities

- Active cooperation within the IT- and Business teams in regards to planning, resource management, communication, reporting and controlling of the project timeframes and financial budgets
- Coordinating the communication between the project teams and internal customers
- Perform detailed project planning, resource scheduling, progress monitoring, issue resolution and risk management
- Establish excellent working relationships with internal and external stakeholders
- Establish governance structure for IT projects. Actively manage all stakeholder engagements (Steering Committees, Project Boards, etc.) and provide regular progress updates



- Communicate issues to project team and the project governing bodies in a timely manner, and asks for intervention when and where necessary
- Business and technical requirements management: Structuring input from stakeholders, ensuring consistency and high quality specifications
- Release and Test management which includes planning testing activities according to project milestones and application releases, structuring of test cases, tracking and ensuring proper documentation of test results
