### **Responsibilities:**

Senior credit analyst to support the management of Rothschild Credit Management's portfolio of leveraged loans. The credit analyst will lead new leveraged finance transactions, including oversight of junior analysts, and manage a portfolio of sector based existing credits. They will be an experienced credit analyst, capable of appraising complex credit transactions, ideally with European leveraged finance or private equity experience, including restructuring experience.

This will include the analysis of new credit opportunities, which the analyst will condense into a concise written form with supporting financial analysis as appropriate. This analysis will then be presented internally to the Investment Committee, and the analyst will be responsible for defending their analysis and answering questions. This analysis will be conducted in the context of broader sector experience.

In addition, the analyst will monitor a portfolio of existing investments, reporting on these as appropriate to other members of the RCM team and making clear recommendations based on qualitative and quantitative analysis to enable the team to buy, hold or sell positions.
